

# CCS GREEN TEAM



The Green Team wrote the application for Cove Creek School to become a NC Green School in April 2017. Because of the efforts of parents, teachers and students to make the school more environmentally aware, Cove Creek was awarded the highest level of recognition through the program, a became a NC Green School of Excellence in June 2018.



## What is the Green Team?

The Green Team at CCS was created a couple of years ago with former principal Toby Cone as a task force to lead the school's green efforts. With Principal Walker's support, the Green Team continues as an arm of the Friends of Cove Creek group and is made up of parents and teachers who support green projects around the school.

Green Team members have written and received grants that made possible the construction of the Cone Garden, the installation of our bee hive and the school solar array that is currently being installed, among others.
