

LIAISON WITH SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATIONS

The Watauga County Board of Education (the “board”) instructs the superintendent to keep it fully informed of the affairs of the state and national school boards associations and to keep these organizations informed as directed regarding the board's concerns and official positions on matters of common concern. The superintendent shall include in each year’s budget the cost of membership in the North Carolina School Boards Association.

All board members are encouraged to attend meetings, conferences and seminars of the state and national organizations in order to familiarize themselves with the latest developments in school affairs. The board may also attempt to be officially represented in association affairs through the election of delegates and/or observers to the governing assemblies of these organizations.
